## **GO 4 IT...NOW!**

#### A STRATEGY TO TEACH STUDENTS TO WRITE PARAGRAPHS ABOUT THEIR IEP GOALS.

# Goals

Objectives

4 (4 objectives)

**I**dentify

Timeline

Name your topic.

Organize details.

Wrap it up and restate topic.

# **Explanation**

This portion of the strategy helps you remember what your IEP goal paragraph is about. In the first sentence, you will name a <u>G</u>oal. In the next four (<u>4</u>) sentences, you will state the <u>O</u>bjectives you will need to accomplish to reach the goal. Finally, in the last sentence, you will <u>I</u>dentify the <u>T</u>imeline for accomplishing the goal.

This portion of the strategy gives you a way to remember the parts of a paragraph. This portion will give you the skills to write paragraphs about <u>any</u> topic, not just paragraphs about your IEP goals and objectives.

### **Example**

One of my goals is to be able to write a complete paragraph. In order to do this, first, I will write complete sentences. Then, I will identify topic sentences and supporting details. Next, I will write a topic sentence and supporting details. Finally, I will use transition words to make my paragraph flow smoothly. I hope to accomplish my goal of being able to write a complete paragraph by the end of this school year.

Did I Name my topic? Yes, my topic was my goal.

Did I **O**rganize my details? Yes, I listed my four objectives in the order I want to accomplish them.

Did I <u>W</u>rap it up? Yes, I ended by saying when I want to

reach my goal, and I restated my topic.
